Sub: Request to provide information under RTI Act-2005.

Dear Sir,

I am enclosing herewith in original Indian Postal Order No. 64E 483331 dated 24.9.08 of Rs., 10/- as a fee for seeking information under RTI Act-2005. Kindly provide me following information:-

1. The number of IRSE 87 Exam officers having lien with Indian Railways with their seniority list. How many ACRs of IRSE 87 exam batch for year 2007-08 were written/available in the Railway Board as on 07/05/08, 10/07/2008 & 24/09/08.
2. As per Chairman, Railway Board Inspection Note No.2008/CRB/Kolkata dated 15/05/08, "There is surplus in SAG cadre. The surplus should be eliminated immediately". Even then it is learnt that SG officers in all services are being promoted to SA Grade causing more surpluses. If it is so, reason thereof. The sanctioned strength viz-a-viz the number of surplus officers in SAG as on 07/05/08, 10/07/08 & 24/09/08 for IRSE, IRSSE, IRSEE, & IRSS may be given.
3. Present points system of promotion to SA Grade including changes in the points system in last 10 years, if any.
4. Name & total number of persons service wise in IRTS, IRAS, IRPS, IRSE, IRSME, IRSEE, IRSS & IRSSE having points lesser than 20 promoted to Senior Admn. Grade in last 12 years with reasons.
5. The copy of time-table for completion of ACRs of officers followed in Railways be given.
6. The name of officer & service whose working report considered for promotion to SAG, HAG, GM & Member level during last 10 years be given.
7. Is it not proper specially in cases where ACR points during last 5 years are less than 20, that latest ACRs & working report of current year be also considered for promotion to SAG or higher grade, if not reasons thereof be given.

8. As per CIC & Supreme Court Judgment in case No.7631 of 2002 dated 12/05/08 (Dev Dutt V/s Union of India & others), it is obligatory & legally binding on the administration to communicate entries in ACRs to employees as right to know & represent. Whether this is being followed in Railways. If not, planning & reasons thereof as non communication would be arbitrary and as such violative of Article 14 of the constitution..
