has now, no basis legality at present at this stage as the same benefit has been meted-out with the similarly placed persons working presently in BPL, Kota Division of W.C. Railway. (a copy of O.O. 910/2010 dt. 27.09.2010 and OO dated26.03.2010 issued by DRM (P), BPL & Kota respectively are enclosed and marked as Annexure-A5 & A6).

It is observed that the attitude of CPO (Engg./Const.) C.Rly, Mumbai CST is totally partial and discriminatory with the applicants (Respondents of C.W.P. 2041/2000) only because of that we the applicants have been continuing struggling for our legal rights since more than 15 years during legal proceedings before Hon'ble CAT (PB) NDLS, Hon'ble High Court Delhi as well as Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

In view of the facts and circumstances as explained above you are therefore very kindly requested to look into the matter personally and review the decision taken by CPO (Engg./Const.), C. Rly, Mumbai CST vide his letter dated 10.08.2011 as referred above and issue necessary orders for proper implementation of Railway Boards policy vide his letter no. as referred above dated 10.06.2009, 04.12.2009 and 25.02.2010 in favour of applicants in the same manner as has been meted out with the similarly placed persons of W.C. Railway (Bhopal & Kota Division) in the interest of justice and also to avoid further litigation in future. An early action in this regard shall be highly appreciated.
