Kindly provide me with following information under RTI ACT 2005

1. After proper signing on duty, if a driver reports any problems related with health/sickness or train operations, as a result of which he unable to perform his scheduled duty, whether he can be marked as absent? Please answer "Yes" or "No".
2. Since the time the Siemens AC/DC rakes were first purchased by the Indian Railways now operational in Mumbai divisions of Central railway and Western railway, what was and is the cost of a 12 car Siemens rake then and now, and all price changes in between with reasons for each price variation.
3. Whether an employee can be marked as Absent, And under what conditions and what should be the procedure for marking absent.
4. If any member of running staff happens to avails a one full day as weekly off, whether his salary can be deducted for that particular day on whether he can be marked as absent and on that day? If the answer to this question is "yes", kindly authenticate the answers with certified copies of relevant rules.
