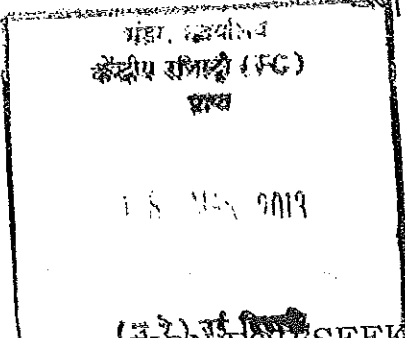

Brief Facts:

Indian Railways have been using various types of papers mainly made of virgin paper from agro-based industry. This was apparently done primarily because DGS&D rate contract till now did not cover recycled paper which is otherwise eco-friendly.

Union Railway Minister Pawan Kumar Bansal presented the Union Railway Budget for 2013-14 in Lok Sabha on 26 February 2013 in which some of the new steps that have been taken or are proposed to be taken on the Green Energy front wherein vide para 47(iv) announced that Railways have encourage use

of recycled paper in addition to agro based as 'green energy initiatives'.

Relevant extract para is as under:-

47. *Railways remain firmly committed to protecting the environment and promoting sustainable development and use of energy efficient technologies. Some of the new steps that have been taken or are proposed to be taken include:-*

iv. encourage more usage of agro-based and recycled paper and ban use of plastic in catering.

It is understood that DGS&D have also now issued rate contract for recycled paper of the same specification as of the virgin papers with no difference in quality.

3. Information sought:- Kindly make available the whole file concerning official correspondence, documentation, transactions, tenders, contract agreement, letter, correspondence concerning the

facts that what action Indian Railways has taken to procure economical and environment friendly recycled paper instead of paper being procured presently.

4. To the best of my knowledge the information sought does not fall within the restrictions contained in Sec 8 and 9 of the Act and it pertains to your office.
