Sub: Information Sought under RTI act

I have enclosed the Indian Postal order Nos 54C160315 dtd 15.03.13 & 54C160316 dtd.15.03.13 (Rs. 5 x 2 = Rs.10) for Rs. 10/- towards the initial fee under RTI act.

I request you to furnish the following information related to Estimates of railway work.

(I am not in need of copies of any documents along with the reply)

In an estimate prepared and sanctioned by railway, the following figures appears.

(1) Cash	=	2,10,31,700
(2) Store	=	1,13,61,200
(3) Total	=	3,23,92,900. (ie cash + store)
(4) Credit amount	=	-9,02,000.
(5) Amount as per this estimate	=	3,32,94,900.

From the detailed estimate pages it is seen that the 'credit' is the value of materials which can be taken by railways in to their account by dismantling some existing structures, track etc.

In this regard, kindly clarify the following.

1. The cost as per 'this estimate' (5) is more than the 'Total' (3) ie by adding the numerical value of 'credit'(4) (by neglecting the negative sign). In fact railways is getting some valuable materials by dismantling. Then, Why the numerical value 'credit' is added to arrive at the net estimated amount ?
2. If this is an estimate related to a deposit work in which the cost is to be borne by another department, what is the amount to be deposited by the party. (3) or (5) ?
3. If the answer to question No. 2 is (5), please furnish the logic of demanding the cost of materials going to railways credit, from the depositing party.
4. If the dismantled materials was originally laid at the cost of depositing party, who will be the owner of the materials after dismantling ?
5. Furnish the relevant circular/ order numbers/ Reference book item numbers etc; if any.
